

Pablo Foundation 2021 Annual Report

Despite another turbulent year of Covid-19 uncertainties, in 2021 we reinforced the course of Pablo Foundation and focused ever more deeply on our mission. On a fundamental level, we centralized information about the Foundation on our website and added an online grant portal. In 2021 alone, these improvements allowed us to efficiently and effectively gift over \$1.5 Million to 38 local non-profit organizations that support health, housing, education, and the arts – the bedrock pillars of our community and of our mission.

We continue to support sustainable solutions that address the systemic issues underlying persistent inequities in our community. Sometimes that means working in concert with existing entities, as in our sponsorship of the Toward One Wisconsin Conference and providing scholarships so participants can attend for free. In other cases, when opportunities don't exist, we create them, as in the case of our partnering with the Eau Claire Area School District to distribute grants to support equity, diversity, and inclusion in the classroom. In all instances we strive to counter and eliminate any systemic racism that affects anyone making their home in the Eau Claire community.

Our ongoing commitment to use our platform as a positive force extends beyond monetary gifts. In 2021, our Board Members voluntarily initiated statements in support of our Asian

American and Pacific Islander neighbors. They also passionately engaged with our grant recipients to find creative ways to stretch every Foundation grant dollar to include as many people from differing backgrounds as possible.

The makeup of our Board matters, and we work hard to seek dynamic, diverse, and engaging Board Members who reflect our deep commitment to fostering a community that respects, honors, and seeks to enrich each other culturally.

After four dedicated years of service, Rebecca Wurzer is rotating off the Pablo Foundation Board. With her background on corporate foundations and ongoing service to several Eau Claire area non-profit organizations, Rebecca was essential in creating the blueprint for Pablo Foundation and securing it for the future.

In 2022, we welcomed new board member Katherine Schneider, PhD. Katherine is an author and retired UW-Eau Claire clinical psychologist. Blind since birth, Katherine is a fierce advocate of accessibility to people of all abilities.

With high hopes that the worst of the Covid-19 pandemic is behind us, we are planning for an active 2022 and look forward to continuing partnerships with local non-profit organizations to help us in carrying out our mission.
